We also operate numerous week long shore based holidays throughout the year to places such as Lanzarote; which has amazing life and the endangered angel sharks. # Welcome to your dive course Here at ROHO

We know you will enjoy the experience and will find that your first dip into diving will open a whole range of pleasure and experience. Our PADI 5 star IDC Centre began in 1981 at Robin Hood Cottage by Bob & Barbara, today our store and on-site facilities are known globally.

All our theory review and pool sessions are completed on site. Our pool sessions are completed in our onsite heated swimming pool. This ensures you are as comfortable as possible during your skills training whether this is your first time underwater or an experienced diver.

Our school equipment is from respected brands across the sport including Apeks, Aqualung and Mares and our full range of in house manufactured ROHO drysuits, will ensure you are nice and warm during all your dives.

The course pack you download will provide you with a copy of the PADI digital manual as well as the access to the touch system to guide you through your home study. Students doing the open water course will also receive a free Robinhood Watersports Log Book Binder and PADI logbook to record their course progress and log your dives. Please read through the dive medical form below, if you answer **YES** to any of the questions you will be required to see a dive doctor prior to starting your course. If you need to see a doctor prior to your course you can find details of registered diving doctors at the shop, please call to speak to one of our dive team

The first step to becoming a diver is to undergo the PADI® Open Water course. This course is world renowned and is suitable for individuals 10 and above.



The Open water course qualifies an individual to dive anywhere in the world with a buddy to a depth of 18 meters,

(there are depth and buddy restrictions for 10-14year olds).

# **OPEN WATER COURSE OUTLINE**

### The PADI® Open Water Course has three parts:

- 1.) Diving Theory & Knowledge Development.
- 2.) Confined Pool Sessions to learn practical scuba skills.
  - 3.) Open Water Dives to use your skills and explore!

#### Part 1: Diving Theory & Knowledge Development

In years gone by this section was a huge thick textbook size manual, nowadays the theory section of the course is self-study which is conducted entirely on-line. Once you have registered with us we will send you an email with the link to follow so you can access and download your training materials. If you do not receive this email within 24hrs please call the shop 01924 444 888 or email <a href="mailto:diveschool@roho.co.uk">diveschool@roho.co.uk</a>

Students receive an electronic link to access and download all training materials relevant to the course. Students must read through, watch videos, answer questions and complete the chapter knowledge reviews on-line.

Once you have downloaded the materials you can start to work your way through the PADI Touch in your own time. Please remember to logon online after each section so your progress can be updated and we can monitor your progress from the shop. There are a total of 5 chapters and on average the home study section of the course takes approximately 8 hours to complete including the exam. When arriving for the confined sessions the instructor will review the knowledge and students will undertake a short exam followed by a tour of the shop, school and pool before going into the water.

However if you are struggling with a particular section at any point, please contact or visit the shop and discuss it with one of our full time instructors.





### Part 2: Confined Pool Sessions

Once all the theory is complete its time to move onto the fun stuff and get wet. If you haven't already arranged your two Saturday pool sessions, then you can call the shop on 01924 444 888 to arrange this. For the pool day you will need to bring the following:

- SWIMMING GEAR + T-SHIRT OR RASH VEST
- TOWEL
- MASK AND SNORKEL
- PACKED LUNCH & WATER (we also have a water fountain for you to refill your drink bottles)

You need to be at Robin Hood Watersports for 10 am for your first Saturday session and 11am for your second Saturday session, depending on how you get on in the pool should be finished around 5pm

The confined pool sessions consist of 5 dives, usually combined to run over a course of two days on consecutive weekends.

In these sessions you will undertake: basic swimming skills, tread water, learn how to assemble your kit, learn and understand what each of the components of the kit is; and why we have it.

You will also learn a number of basic scuba diving skills that you will carry with you for the rest of your diving career. After a period of time very much like driving a car you will do these skills automatically and without even thinking. For example; clearing your mask is one of the most frequent skills you will do. Getting water in your mask is a fact of diving no matter how good the fit of the mask is, but there is a simple effective technique to overcome this.

The confined sessions are also about improving your confidence both in and out of the water. You will have an experienced PADI <sup>®</sup> Instructor with you throughout your training alongside a PADI <sup>®</sup> Professional Dive Master.

During your confined training sessions you will be given the opportunity to complete the PADI Dry Suit specialty add-on. This speciality course is very important firstly; the dry-suit qualification will give you confidence to use your suit without PADI Pro supervision. Secondly; the qualification will allow you to hire a dry suit anywhere in the world.

Without the speciality, you will find it very difficult to hire a drysuit from retailers; due to safety and training concerns. The add-on course is an additional £75 and includes 1 extra dive on your open water weekend.





#### **DRYSUIT ORIENTATION**

If you are completing your open water dives with us, you will need to attend a DrySuit orientation evening. This is conducted the Wednesday or Thursday evening before your open water weekend. You will be required to come down to the shop to be sized up for your drysuit and given an in water orientation ready for the weekend. You will also need your swim gear and towel too.

#### Part 3: Open Water Dives

The third and final part of the PADI® Open Water course is, where you take everything that you have learned from your home-study and the confined training dives to open water. Again there are several ways we approach this;

One is for you to complete your dives on holiday, the second is to complete your dives on one of our organised training holidays, or the third and most popular; is to take advantage of our open water weekends at the Inland Dive Site Capernwray in Lancaster.

At Capernwray you will complete a series of 4 dives over 2 days. During the course of your first dive, you *will* perform several skills at the instructor's discretion. This initial dive will allow you to become comfortable with diving in your drysuit and also acclimatise you to the surroundings of diving amongst curious fish and underwater attractions.

Dives 2, 3 and 4 will also contain a variety of skills for you to perform and depths for you to explore. The weekend will also see you enter and exit the water in various ways (this is designed to mimic real entry and exit points in diving). There is also an opportunity for you to undertake a Drysuit speciality on the Sunday afternoon which requires just one additional dive.

#### What's Included:



The Open Water Course price (above) includes all of your equipment, cylinders, lead and the training materials that you will require.

<u>Due to Health & Safety reasons; we insist that all students purchase their own mask and snorkel.</u>

We also strongly recommend that all students look to purchase their own hood and Gloves.

We offer a great selection of equipment in the store and online with special packages specifically tailored towards new students.

#### **What's Not Included:**

#### Entry Fees & Air Fills

Entry fees are £15 each day totalling £30 for the entire weekend.

You will also be required to pay for your own air fills which are £6 each. Over the course of the weekend you will require a total of 3 fills.

Note: If you decide to upgrade onto the Drysuit distinctive speciality you will require an addition air fill.

### Capernwray Two Year Membership £30

In the U.K we use an inland dive site called Capernwray which is located in Carnforth just north of Lancaster on the M6. Capernwray is a fresh water site that has numerous underwater attractions including: planes, helicopters, cars, vans and boats.

Not to mention the exceptionally friendly local wildlife; particularly the trout. Capers is also home to shoals of Perch and Roach, recent

additions of rather colourful carp, then



there are the Sturgeons, the elusive fresh water eel and the Pike.



In order to dive at Capernwray all new students must register for a lifetime membership. This is a one off fee of £29. Lifetime membership allows you to access to the site and all of the facilities that Capernwray has to offer.
